Small pullback in confidence

- Headline consumer confidence was down 0.9%, with most subindices falling as we draw nearer to the end of the JobKeeper program.
- 'Current financial conditions' declined 2.5%, 'future financial conditions' fell 0.6%.
- 'Current economic conditions' weakened 0.6% and 'future economic conditions' fell 1.1%
- Going against the overall trend, the 'Time to buy a major household item' gained 0.1%. 'Weekly inflation expectations' remained at 3.8%, while the four-week moving average increased 0.1% to 3.8%.



ANZ Head of Australian Economics, David Plank, commented:


Consumer confidence slipped 0.9% last weekend despite the federal government's \$1.2 billion support package aimed at restoring interstate tourism demand. We don't think the drop in confidence was related to the two new COVID cases. The one in Sydney was revealed too late to be captured by the survey, while confidence in Queensland fell by a lot less than some of the other states. It is possible the drop in confidence could be linked to consumers being apprehensive about a future without the JobKeeper program, or the small decline could simply be a pure 'noise' in the data.

Figure 2. 'Current financial conditions' weakened 2.5%






Figure 3. 'Future financial conditions' softened 0.6%




Figure 4. 'Current economic conditions' lost 0.6%






Figure 5. 'Future economic conditions' dropped 1.1%




Figure 6. 'Time to buy a major household item' gained 0.1%





Figure 7. The four-week moving average for inflation expectations rose 0.1% to 3.8%
