Thank you once again for undertaking to give the Separation Tree Oration.

The Separation Tree Ceremony commemorates the announcement of the separation of Victoria from New South Wales on the 14th of November, 1850 under the Separation Tree by Governor Latrobe.

The Separation Tree Ceremony this year will be at the tree (enter from Morell Bridge gate, corner Anderson Street and Alexander Avenue) at 10.30 a.m. on the 14th of November, 2009 (159th Anniversary).

The ceremony is as follows:

10.30 a.m. Reading of proclamation by Town Crier

10.35 a.m. Volley of fire by the Victorian Re-enactment Society/Colonial Infantry

10.37 a.m. Oration at the Tree by Mr. Gary Morgan (usually 10 - 20 minutes as the venue is outside)

Tea follows in the Botanical Gardens Kiosk which is nearby.

The Ceremony is attended by MP's and City Councillors and some members of the public (usually about one hundred people). We also usually have excellent coverage by the press and television.
