## VICTORIA'S 157<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY

We will be celebrating the 157<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Separation of Victoria and New South Wales on the 1<sup>st</sup> of July. On that day 157 years ago, Victoria achieved not only its separate geographic boundaries, but also Responsible Government with the formation of the Victorian Parliament. Other Victorian institutions including the Supreme Court and the Public Service also commenced on this important day. (A public holiday prior to World War 1.)

### The Flag raising and Award Ceremony

On Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> of July at 10.30 a.m., there will be the Victorian flag raising ceremony and the re-enactment of Governor LaTrobe's reading of the proclamation at the Melbourne Town Hall. At 11.00 a.m. the Victoria Day Awards will be presented in the Lower Town Hall by the Governor of Victoria, Professor David de Kestner AO. Refreshments will be served in the Portico Room. Attendance at the flag raising is free. The Award Ceremony and Reception will cost \$10.00 per person.
